- a) **Arolwg – Canfyddiadau Dysgwyr Newydd** – cyflwynodd Elliw Ellis Davies o Gwmni ATOM PR adroddiad i'r aelodau ar rai o brif bwyntiau'r arolwg. (gweler Papur CHa). Bydd yr adroddiad llawn yn cael ei e-bostio at yr aelodau. Prif nodweddion:
  - y wasg / hysbysebion darparwyr oedd y ffynhonnell wybodaeth amlycaf ar gyfer cyrsiau
  - lefel boddhad yn uchel
  - mae diffyg ymwybyddiaeth amlwg o frand CiO ac ymwybyddiaeth o wefan y Ganolfan
- b) **Strategaeth Farchnata 2009/2010** – cyflwynodd EED y strategaeth ac yn dilyn trafodaeth cafwyd rhai argymhellion:

- Cytunwyd ei bod yn bwysig fod tiwtoriaid a staff sy'n gweithio yn y maes yn ymwybodol o'r gyfundrefn ond eilradd ddylai'r pwyslais fod ar godi ymwybyddiaeth ymhlith dysgwyr.
- 'Roedd anfodlonrwydd ymysg yr aelodau ynglŷn â system 'LearnDirect'. Eglurwyd fod cytundeb rhwng y cwmni a'r Llywodraeth ar fin dod i ben ac na fyddai yn cael ei adnewyddu.

- 9. Hyfforddiant** – Cyflwynodd Haydn Hughes bapur i'r aelodau gan dynnu sylw penodol at y canlynol:
- Mae 22 o ddarpar diwtoriaid wedi derbyn hyfforddiant a'u manylion wedi eu cylchredeg i'r darparwyr. Mae profiad wedi dangos pwysigrwydd mentora'r bobl hyn ar y dechrau a gall y Ganolfan gynnig eu gwasanaeth i'r darparwyr llai i'r diben hwn.

Yn wyneb hyn mae'n cynnig sefydlu Bwrsari gyda chronfa o £10K i lenwi'r bwllch. Gofynnwyd i'r Ganolfan gynhyrchu taflen yn amlinellu pob cronfa sydd ar gael ynghyd a chanllawiau.

Strategaeth Addysg Cyfrwng Cymraeg** - cyflwynodd yr Athro Merfyn Jones adroddiad llafar gan gyfeirio at y ffaith fod y strategaeth wedi ei hysgrifennu yn Saesneg a'i chyfieithu i'r Gymraeg gyda'r canlyniad fod anghysonderau yn y fersiwn Gymraeg. **The minutes of the last meeting were confirmed as correct.**

### 3. Matters Arising

- Point 5, Item 3 – The arrangement with Coleg Meirion Dwyfor for the administration of the Contingency Fund has been a success and an agreement has been reached for this to continue for 2009/10.
- Point 9 – Workplace Training Research – initial meetings have been held with the Welsh Language Board and a memorandum of understanding will be drawn up. The Centre will continue to offer a workplace provision planning service for the public sector and the Welsh Language Board will change its system of monitoring, implementing this on a 'sample' basis in future. The Board's emphasis will be upon ensuring that public bodies work towards the realization of their strategy.
- The Centre has received confirmation of the 2009/2010 financial allocation and the proposed allocations will stand. IG will contact the providers to confirm.

### 4. Minutes of the Quality Panel that was held on 17.06.09

The minutes were accepted and the attention of the members was drawn to the following:

- Student Evaluation Forms – the Centre will proceed to devise a uniform system in collaboration with DCELLS.
- ESTYN Inspection – ESTYN's timetable for the inspection of Welsh for Adults in this region in 2009/2010 is not yet known but it is believed they will visit Gwynedd and Anglesey and the Centre will certainly be inspected as a region at the end of 2010. Systems are being put in place to plan for this; the aim of the Centre is to raise awareness of the Centre and increase the sense that the tutors in every institution are part of the same team.
- Self-assessment Document – for practical reasons the Centre will present its Self-assessment in November from now on. A pro forma will be drawn up, to be completed by providers by the end of October. In it the Centre will request specific general information which is required to feed into the report.

### 5. Minutes of the Provider Panel that was held on 17.06.09

- Welsh for the Family National Course – Pam Evans-Hughes, the Centre's Development Officer, is one of the authors of this course. It will be piloted in 2010/2011 and the Centre will ask WEA to introduce this course in North Wales as a mainstream course, at Entry level in the first instance.
- Every provider has either reached their target or is close to doing so and we as a region will receive an increase in funding of 10% in 2009/10. IG thanked everyone for their hard work to secure this.

### 6. Marketing Strategy

- b) **Survey – Perceptions of New Learners** - Eilw Ellis Davies from ATOM PR Company presented a report to the members on some of the survey's main points. (see paper CHa). The full report will be e-mailed to members. Main features:
  - The press/provider advertisements were the most obvious information source for courses.
  - Satisfaction level was high
  - There is a lack of awareness of the Welsh for Adults brand and awareness of the Centre's website.
- b) **Marketing Strategy 2009/10** – EED presented the strategy and, following discussion, some recommendations were made:

- It was agreed that it was important for tutors and staff who are working in the field to be conscious of the set up but the emphasis on raising awareness amongst learners should be secondary.
- There was dissatisfaction among the members concerning the 'LearnDirect' system. It was explained that an agreement between the company and the Government was about to come to an end and it would not be renewed.
- A national on-line strategy is being developed that will be an effective communication resource for learners in due course.
- It would be an advantage if the articles in Golwg were available in a simplified form for learners – this already exists on their website.

**7. Strategic Objectives** – IG presented a paper outlining the Centre's main Strategic Objectives

- Point 1 – it was agreed to change the word 'learners' to WfA tutors/staff and raise the target to 100%
- Point 3 – the Centre is seeking additional external funding sources
- Points 5-11 – the increase target is unavoidably general as this year is the first time the data has been collected
- Point 8 – the Assembly's aim is to increase confidence amongst those who already possess some Welsh
- Point 12-14 – the region's alternative provision includes Llanllawen and Accelerated Learning courses. The Government intends to develop a national WfA curriculum so that the same course is used throughout Wales.
- Point 18 – it was agreed to reword the point giving a specific target for tutors to receive Grade 1 or 2
- The objectives will be incorporated into the Contracts.

**8. Contracts** – IG presented a paper to members outlining the Proposed Changes to the Third Party Contracts, and members were asked to consider them with their staff and report back by 24<sup>th</sup> July.

The following were agreed:

- 3.1 It is important that the person who makes the telephone calls has received appropriate training in order to obtain the requisite information in a sensitive manner.
- 7.2 It was requested that a calendar be prepared of which data is required and when, and that the learners on the pro forma be grouped according to the class in which they are enrolled.
- 7.5 Add "conditional upon the permission of the learner"
- 9.6 Add "this will be operational from 2010/2011"

**9. Training** – Haydn Hughes presented a paper to the members specifically highlighting the following:

- 22 potential tutors have received training and their details have been circulated to the providers. Experience has shown the importance of mentoring these people at the beginning and the Centre can offer its service to the smaller providers for this purpose.
- Training for co-ordinators and full time tutors will be held 13-15 July and the Centre's training programme for 2009/10 will be discussed there.
- 144 classes were observed in 2008-09 and 151 tutors. An analysis of the results may be seen in paper E.

**10. Bursary** – IG presented a paper to the members explaining that there is a gap in the funding support that is being offered to learners as it does not offer assistance with course fees. In the light of this, it proposes the establishment of a Bursary, with a £10k fund, to fill the gap. The Centre was asked to produce a leaflet outlining every fund that is available together with guidelines.

**11. Welsh Medium Education Strategy** – Professor Merfyn Jones gave a verbal report referring to the fact that the strategy had been written in English and translated into Welsh, which led to inconsistencies in the Welsh version. It has been planned principally with the situation in non-Welsh speaking areas in mind and is therefore more relevant to organizations in those localities than to those in North Wales. There is only a supportive reference in it to Welsh for Adults but there is scope for collaboration on two subjects, namely

- Development of staff language skills
- Welsh in the Workplace training

There will be a meeting at Bangor on Friday, 10<sup>th</sup> July, and IG will present observations on the document from the standpoint of WfA following this meeting.

12. **A.O.B** – the Chair thanked Mr Wyn Hobson, the Meeting Translator, for his considerable hard work in the course of the Centre's meetings.
