Election of Chairman: It was proposed that Elwyn Hughes should remain as Chair for another year, there was no amendment and Elwyn agreed to continue with the work. He was thanked for his tireless service.

Paper A, Paper B, Paper C(a) and Paper C(b) were distributed with the agenda prior to the meeting.

1. Minutes of the meeting held on 17/06/09 (Paper A) – the minutes were found to be correct.

2. Matters arising from the minutes

7. Training – the intention had been to offer the qualification in a year in 2009/2010 but the conditions were changed and as it would be necessary to observe a substantial number of additional classes during the year under the new conditions, this would be impractical and it was decided not to offer the qualification this year.

8. Data - the Centre had reached its target and had received additional funding. Some providers had difficulty achieving their target; it is becoming increasingly important to succeed in doing this. IG emphasised the importance that everyone should monitor their performance and ensure that targets are reached this year.

3. Publicity and Marketing – Eiliw Ellis Davies was welcomed to the meeting to present a report on the work of ATOM PR Company thus far. Eiliw reported that the background work that had been carried out during the last two years was now bearing fruit and that there was visual material to be shown. She gave an introduction to the website in its new form -

- Tutors – there is more development work to be done in this section
- News – any stories or pictures for this section would be welcomed
- Learners – providers were asked to encourage their tutors to promote the use of the website among the learners and to report back with feedback to the link 'Ymarfer eich Cymraeg'
- A Word a Day – a link is being developed to the Gair y Dydd campaign on Heart FM

National Developments

- Establish on-line contacts by using networks such as twitter, facebook etc.
- A discussion forum for tutors

Atom Company and the Centre are about to launch a campaign with a learner from Caernarfon who is similar to the television character 'Jim Royle'. He has set himself the challenge of learning Welsh in order to become more part of his community and has agreed to write a blog and provide stories for the press. It is hoped this will raise the profile of WfA among a new audience.

Eiliw showed the leaflets that have been printed and the national WfA brand prominent on them. She has asked the Assembly about the possibility of producing templates that providers can use for marketing purposes. This suggestion was welcomed.

- 4. Strategic Planning of the Provision** – JG and PEH explained the background to the process and presented a provision planning process and timetable for the coming year. Those present were divided into two groups to discuss questions that arose from this. At the end of the workshop the experiment was found to have been valuable, that everyone had contributed and that it would be good practice for the future. The feedback will be used to draw up a paper for the Strategic Group on the strategic direction of provision planning.
- 5. Informal Learning** (Paper B) – SH presented the paper outlining informal learning activities that have been held since the last meeting and giving details of what is being planned. There were no comments or questions.
- 6. Training** (Paper C(a)) – SD presented the paper reporting on the training that has been conducted thus far this year, the feedback from it and the training that has been arranged for the remainder of the term. There were no comments or questions.
- 7. Training** (Paper C(b)) – HH presented the paper outlining the structure of the training for prospective tutors in 2009/2010. Observation of experienced tutors at their work will be an important component of the training. The Centre was taking action to seek HEFCW accreditation for this training.
